

Attention Please Read

The new Connecticut Mandate with regards to fertility treatment

Coverage, up to age 40 (does not include fortieth year)

Ovulation Induction- 4cycles lifetime

IUI-3 cycles lifetime

1W- 2 cycles lifetime with a limit of no more than 2 embryos transferred per cycle. Any fertilization or transfer shall be credited toward maximum as one cycle (i.e., FET)

If MD feels low tech option like IUI will not work patients can move directly to 1W; however the spirit of the ACT is for patients to try and fail low tech options before moving on to IVF.

“LOOKBACK PROVISION” After October 1, 2005 if a patient undergoes treatment(s) with an insurance plan and subsequently changes plans, all prior treatments must be disclosed to the new plan and will count towards lifetime maximums.

The new Connecticut Mandate with regards to fertility treatment states that the patient MUST complete the Connecticut disclosure form, send the notarized original to your current insurance company and bring a copy to the office (we would be happy to make these copies).

Once this has been done, the office can then pre-cert your care for fertility treatment.
